# **Cuomo Uses Eviction Moratorium to Stay in Office**

A fter facing forced departure from New York's Gubernatorial Mansion, Governor Andrew "Slippery Thumbs" Cuomo was handed an Ex Machina — this morning, a federal judge upheld the U.S. eviction moratorium.

Cuomo was pressured to resign after damning evidence of his Italian heritage came to light. President Biden immediately requested Cuomo's resignation, citing an old Irish parable.
